

## Media Release Non-Consent Form September 2019

Pursuant to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), schools are permitted to release "school directory information" unless parents exercise their right of refusal. Under FERPA law, this information could include: student name, residential address, E-mail address, phone numbers, photographs/images, school locations, field of study, degrees, honors and awards received and participation in athletics and other activities.

It is the intent and practice of the Primary Prep Elementary and Middle School to publish, post or distribute a student's name, photograph, audio/or video recordings, displays of student work or other information related only to student achievement (e.g., academic/athletic recognition or award) or student accomplishment (e.g., a specially selected piece of work).

By signing and returning this form to my child's school, I formally state that I <u>DO NOT</u> grant permission to Primary Prep to release my child's name, photograph, audio and/or video recording, or displays of work to the media; to publish information about my child's accomplishments or achievements in school-sponsored publications; or to display such information at various school functions during the 2019-2020 school year. Examples include the following:

- A program from a concert, sporting event, or playbill showing a student's role in a production, event, or performance;
- The annual yearbook;
- Public galleries or exhibitions of student work; and
- Honor roll, recognition lists, or graduation programs.
